For more than a decade, Seattle Riot has been a dominating force in Women's Ultimate Frisbee on the national and international stage.

As 7-time National Finalists, Riot has won the National Title twice - in 2004 and 2005. We took home the World Championship in 2002. In recent years, we have never placed lower than third at any tournament.

Beyond our competitive success, Riot is a dedicated partner to the community of Seattle and to the greater Ultimate community. Through coaching initiatives, community events and international outreach, Riot shows our commitment to growing the sport of Ultimate and promoting a positive culture of sports.

Seattle Riot gives our sponsors national and world-wide exposure not only to the fans who come to watch at our tournaments, and attend our community events, but also though the ESPN coverage of all USAU Triple Crown Events. Games from these tournaments are streamed online through ESPN3 and can be watched in over 83 million homes in the US.

Other media coverage comes from Ultimate specific video streaming services and online content.

Locally:

The Seattle Ultimate community is the largest of any city in the country. We have nearly 1,000 players at the competitive level (registered with USAU). Approximately 10,000 people play some form of Ultimate in Seattle.

Of that number, nearly 3,000 are youth players. There are 150+ youth teams in the area between elementary school, middle school and high school teams.

Globally:

Ultimate is played in a least 80 countries worldwide by an estimated 7 million people.

Our Impact:

We connect with our fans not only through our competitions, but also through extensive community outreach in Seattle and around the world.

As coaches of youth teams in Seattle, organizers of after-school Ultimate programs, and hosts of clinics for hundreds of local players, we strive to make a positive impact in our community.

Riot is know around the world not only because of our level of play, but also because we run more international clinics and events than any other team. In 2013, we hosted 41 clinics for over 1,500 players in 10 different countries.
